GDC Nowshera Organized General Awareness Programme Regarding Social Issues




Government Degree College Nowshera today conducted a scholarship awareness programme,

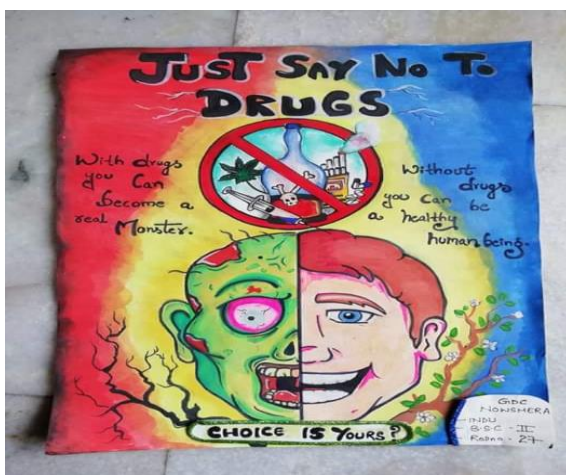
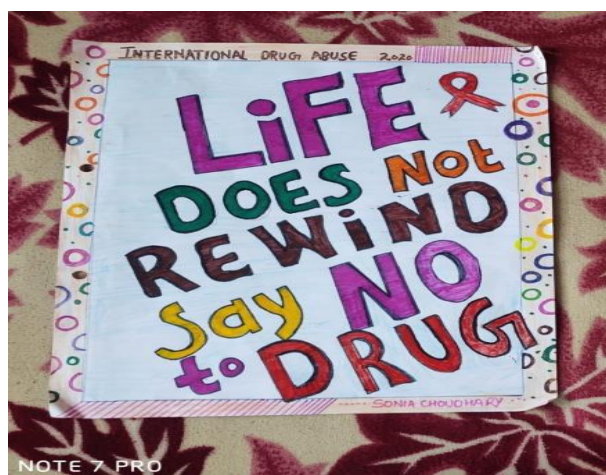
2. **CELEBRATION OF WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY, 2020 on 14/06/2020.**


