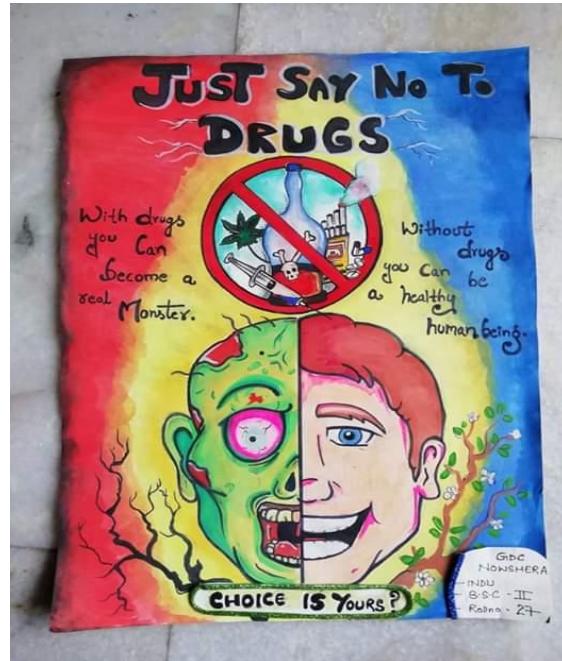
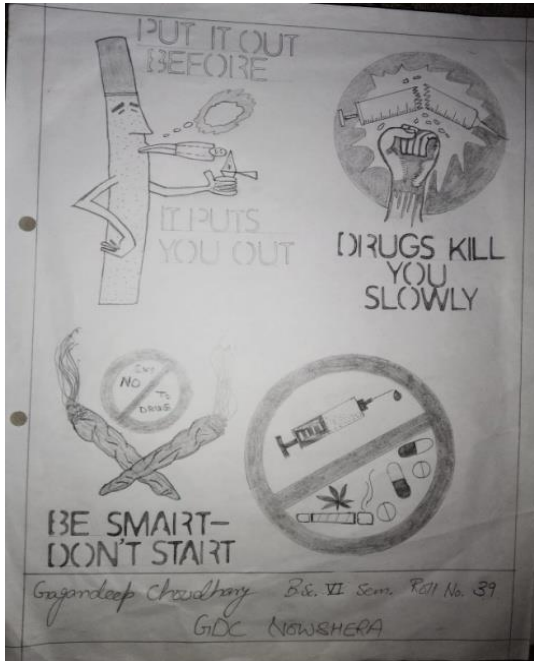
The Red Ribbon Club, GDC Nowshera organized a Poster making competition on the theme, "Drugs, A Grave Mistake".
